Hi,

If we're talking about the change of IP of host serving RhodeCode servers that shouldn't be any problem. RhodeCode doesn't really rely on any binding to specific IPs only thing that needs to be considered is any IP restrictions set for an instance, if suddenly wrong SOURCE ip are sent to rhocode instance it might block them by defined IP rules (maybe a global IP of proxy server which was set ?)
