- `beaker.session.secret`
- `rhodecode.encrypted_values.secret`

If this doesn't help we'll check more option to try to figure this one out.

Assuming this is the file `./rccontrol/enterprise-1/rhodecode.ini`

• There is no value `rhodecode.encrypted_values.secret` in the file `./rccontrol/enterprise-1/rodhecode.ini` "Pattern not found: `rhodecode.encrypted_values.secret`"

• The value for `beaker.session.secret` is the same on both servers = `ebe6ce8ec4d742f29b5b95db70ea35d5`
